



CLC Worldwide Teacher Scholarship

Purpose: The CLC Worldwide scholarship will be awarded to a college-bound high school senior based on demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and an expressed interest in pursuing a degree in education.

Criteria: Students eligible for assistance must be a graduating high school senior who reside in Georgia, intends to continue their education at a four-year college or university and plans to pursue a degree in education in the fall of 2019. Students must also possess a 2.5 GPA and be a U.S. Citizen. Consideration will be based on academic achievement, financial need and written essay.

Guidelines: Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed in equal payments in August and January. Students must continue to attend classes and maintain no lower than a 2.5 grade-point average (or equivalent).

Amount: One scholarship will be awarded annually. Two equal installments will be sent directly to recipients' school of acceptance, which must be verified by CLCWW scholarship department

Deadline: The application deadline is May 30th. The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted.

Renewal process: This scholarship is not renewable. Only high school seniors intending to enroll in a four-year college or university are eligible to apply. Previous scholarship recipients cannot re-apply.

Teacher Scholarship Essay

Write a (1000 word minimum) doubled-spaced essay of why you want to become a teacher and how you will make positive impact on your students.

Points will be awarded as follows:

25pts. Ideas 25pts. Organization 25pts. Content 25pts. Conventions

Incomplete applications will not be accepted. All application materials must be postmarked by May 30, 2019.
